

I am DeafBlind. I have noticed when voting that the electronic ballots most commonly used are difficult to use due to my vision. I would prefer to be able to adjust the size of the font to a readable size rather than being forced to stick to one uniform size. A paper ballot would be worse because I have to put my face about an inch from the paper to read paper ballots because the font is very small on paper. I think a solution would be to offer electronic ballots that have adjustable font sizes and adjustable color contrast (for people who prefer colors other than black on white). Also, ballots in Braille should be offered for voters who have no residual vision. I have residual vision so I mainly just need large print ballots, but I know other blind individuals struggle with voting because of a lack of accessible options. I also feel that poll workers should be trained with working with disabled people. I have struggled to understand poll workers during the COVID 19 pandemic because I can't read their lips through their masks. Perhaps the government could supply poll workers with clear masks.
